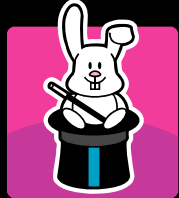

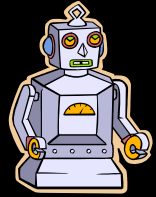

Courses Offered This Spring at UES:

(Find a class you like and see when it is being held in our chart to the left).

All classes begin the week of April 14 and run 2:45pm-3:45pm.

Snack is back! All students will receive snack before class. Pick up is no later than 4:00pm.

Become a Magician (Grades 4-6) – This is one of those feel-great classes! Students who love to entertain and want to learn fun tricks should sign-up for this exciting class. Depending on the popularity of this offering, we will consider offering a younger version next season.

Beginning French (Grades 2-5) – Students in this course will dive into the French language in a variety of fun ways. French games, worksheets and speaking activities will be played weekly. Emphasis will be placed on intonation, rhythm, vowel sounds and linkage between words.

Capoeira (Grades 2-6) – One of our favorites! We first began offering this course in our summer camp years ago and now, for the first time, we bring it to you as an after-school enrichment class. Capoeira is a Brazilian martial art form that combines dance, rhythm, and movement. Music and self-expression are intricate segments that form this fun enrichment offering.

Ceramics (Grades K-3) (Grades 4-6) – Two separate courses for your creative kids! Students in the **K-3 course** focus on basic ceramic principles and techniques, while the older (**Grades 4-6**) course dives deeper into glazing techniques and larger pottery projects. All students end the course with fired ceramics of which they can be proud.

Chess for Beginners (Grades 2-6) – Students in this class will be trained by nationally-known chess instructor Mark Rosenberg, who himself has trained nationally-ranked chess competitors. This course is specifically for students who have not been trained in Chess before.

Field Sports (Grades K-1) – It's back! This popular outdoor course is a great way to end the day with exercise and fun. Freeze Tag, Capture the Flag, Obstacle Courses and much more are played during this 8-week class.

Hip-Hop Dance (Grades 2-6) – This contemporary dance form is the perfect blend of exercise and coordination! Students will learn choreographed routines to the songs they love.

Learn to Fly Finale (Grades 2-5) – This is your last chance to take part in the most popular enrichment class of the year! Students learn and use video cameras, green screens, forced perspective, camera tricks and more in this awesome class. This will be the LAST OFFERING of Learn to Fly at Seeds UES. Space has filled up fast each time, so don't wait. All students leave with a DVD movie of their special effects!

Painting and Drawing (Grades K-1) – This class focuses on patterns in artwork. Students learn and practice basic drawing skills, as well as watercolor painting techniques. Construction paper, pencils, markers, watercolors, and colored pencils will be used.

Ultimate Sports (Grades 4-6) – Students spend the afternoon getting a great dose of exercise with the "ultimate" versions of such games as kickball, soccer, capture the flag, Frisbee, and more!

Vex Robotics (Grades 4-6) – One of PlanetBravo's most popular summer courses comes to Seeds. Students here will learn the principles of engineering while building Vex robots in small groups. At the start of this 8-week course, students will be given a mission for their robots and will build them accordingly. Critical thinking skills are a must in this course. **\$50 lab fee** additional.

Video Editing (Grades 2-6) – This course takes movie production to the next level. Using footage from the UES campus, students learn to import the video to the computer, edit in iMovie and package onto DVD. All students leave with their own DVD version of their final cut.
