Camp Courses - Weekly Tracks

VIDEO GAME CREATION TRACK (Varies by location, Gr. 4-10)

A very popular and engaging course for our video game enthusiasts. Students start with a blank white stage and fill it with backgrounds, characters, props (and almost anything they can think of) while programming all objects to come to life and form a real video game of their own. Software used: Multimedia Fusion 2, Acid Music, Photoshop, and more.



MOVIE PRODUCTION TRACK (Varies by location, Gr. 4-8)



For years, this course has entertained and enlightened hundreds of students looking to bring a new angle to their video cameras and computers. Students in this course not only shoot their own video footage at camp (using our cool equipment), they also learn to edit them on the computer! Students in this course leave with their own DVD of their final movie.

Software used: Pinnacle Studio, Acid Music, Photoshop, and more.

WEB ENTERTAINMENT TRACK (Varies by location, Gr. 4-10)

A video game, a cartoon and their very own web page! Students in this class will leave camp with their own video game and cartoon playing on their very own page LIVE on the web. (Password protected upon request). Software used: Scratch, Flash, Nvu, Photoshop, Acid Music, and more.



MULTIMEDIA YOUTH TRACK (Grades 2-3)

A very special track for our youngest campers. Students in this track take a make-believe job as a media specialist for their favorite company (Disney, NFL, Nickelodeon, etc.). They use Photoshop, ACID Music, Digital Cameras, Camcorders, and more for a week filled with multimedia projects.

3D GAME PROGRAMMING (Grades 6-10)

Students in this track focus on what it takes to actually develop programs for this high-tech world. 3D Game Programming is the primary focus (using lite C) in this offering. Students map out a 3D game, then bring it to life with programming.

This is a 'MASTERS CAMP'-only course! Students will use Apple's Final Cut Pro Express to edit their own movie masterpieces. It's time to learn how the pros do it.
