Techno-tainment Camp

Since 2003, Techno-tainment Camp has been a source of multimedia summer fun in Beverly Hills. Hosted by the Beverly Hills Recreation and Parks Department and founded by award-winning technology teacher Danny Pezzotta, Techno-tainment Camp has taught hundreds of children to make movies, create video games, design websites and much more. Filling up all seats weeks in advance and having to limit the number of sessions campers could attend, it was clear the camp needed to expand.

CAMP COURSES

Multimedia Arts: Grades 2-3 (Classic only) - Our youngest campers get to explore multimedia tools with activities such as editing and taking photographs, mixing music, designing web pages and even editing video!

Creative Crew: Grades 2-3 (Classic only) - **NEW!** A group of young stars come together to make a movie. Campers in this class run the cameras, perform and edit their own video! They leave camp with a DVD of the group movie!



Video Game Design: Grades 4-10 (Classic and Masters) - This is the program they've all been talking about. This summer, it's gotten even better! Multimedia Fusion 2 is out! Campers have a blast making their own video games and showing them off to friends.

Animation: Grades 4-10 (Classic and Masters) **NEW!** - It's not just 3D animation anymore! We're also using new 2D software that's easy and fun. Campers make all types of cartoons and bring them home on CD.

Digital Video Production: Grades 4-10 (Classic and Masters) - This class has become very popular. Campers develop, direct, edit and star in their own movies. A classic course!

Robotics / RoboHead: Grades 6-10 (Classic and Masters) - **NEW!** Offered sessions 3-5 in Beverly Hills and sessions 6-8 in Westwood, this course allows campers to build VEX Design System robots! Last year we had the privilege of the Beverly Hills Robotics Team visiting every week; now we want to build our own! Unlike our competing camps, campers don't build only one robot in a large group; they build their own! Lab fee of \$100 is payable on the first day of camp.

Game Programming: Grades 6-10 (Classic and Masters) - **NEW!** Now you can do it like the pros! We use actual programming language to make very advanced games. 3D game-making available at Masters location!

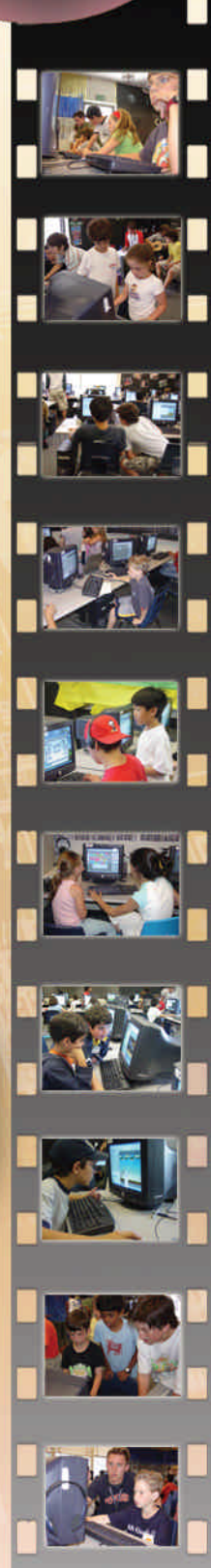
Digital DJ: Grades 6-10 (Masters only) - **NEW!** So many people have iPods now. It was only a matter of time before people started making their own "radio" shows for them (podcasts). We'll have you recording your own show and keeping it going long after you leave camp. Get famous in a brand-new way! Also learn sound-effects mixing.

Website Design: Grades 4-10 (Classic and Masters) - With websites becoming more important to the world each year, campers here get on board and make their own dynamic websites in class. They can even edit their sites from home!

TOURNAMENT TRACK - Grades 4-10 (Classic and Masters) - Yes, it's back. Are you ready to really show off your skills? It's time to apply your Techno-tainment skills in Digital Video or Game Design, and make a master project to have the whole camp cheer. Trophies are awarded to top master projects each week. **FOR RETURNERS ONLY.**
